

About Theatre on the Road

Theatre of the Road, the parent company of Murder Cafe, offers more traditional theatre pieces such as "Poe Live", "A Christmas Carol", "Whiskey Women", "War of the Worlds", "Dracula", "Arsenic and Old Lace", and "A Taste of Shakespeare".





These productions, along with a selection of music, comedy, drama, and variety shows are available to be performed at almost any location including cafes, restaurants, theaters, performance spaces, and schools.

Theatre on the Road also specializes in "living history" and produces and performs at historic sites in Kingston, Hurley, Woodstock, and Rhinebeck, New York.

In 2023, Theatre on the Road performed 51 murder mysteries, 12 Christmas Carols shows, 10 performances of Dracula, and four cemetery tours.

Historic Character Lectures

Beginning in 2020 at Mohonk Mountain House, and now touring around the region, Frank Marquette offers lectures in-character on two spirited Hudson Valley subjects: **Ghost Stories** and **The Bootleg Era.**

Both topics are riddled with fascinating tales, colorful characters, interesting themes, and true events that not only shaped local history, but influenced the nation.


